How To Create a USPS Business Customer Gateway Account (BCG)

If you don't have a USPS Business Customer(BCG) Log On – below are the steps to create one. Almost all Mail Owners and Mail Service Providers have a USPS CRID. A CRID is a Customer Registration ID with the USPS. This is a step-by-step guide to create a BCG account and use your exiting CRID and not create a new CRID which can cause issues.
